

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 299620

ADOPTED ON SEP 13 2004

A RESOLUTION APPROVING PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS; AUTHORIZING ESTABLISHMENT OF PHASE FUNDING AND AWARD OF PUBLIC WORKS CONTRACT; AND TAKING RELATED ACTIONS.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the plans and specifications for the construction of Sewer and Water Group 726 [Project], filed in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. W.O. 176491/186541, are approved.

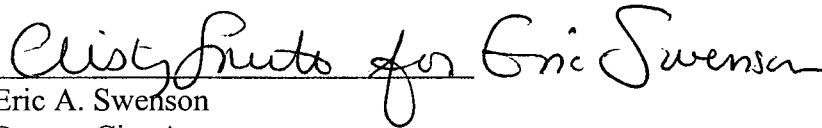
2. That, after advertising for bids in accordance with law, the City Manager is authorized to establish contract funding phases and to award the Project contract to the lowest responsible and reliable bidder, provided that the City Auditor and Comptroller first furnishes one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure under established contract funding phases are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

3. That the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$3,540,425 from Sewer Fund 41506, CIP No. 44-001.0, Annual Allocation- Sewer Main Replacement, an amount not to exceed \$2,062,292 from Water Fund 41500, CIP No. 73-083.0, Annual Allocation – Water Main Replacement, is authorized solely and exclusively for the purpose of providing funds for the Project and related costs, provided that the City Auditor and Comptroller first furnishes one or more certificates certifying that the funds are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

4. That the use of City Forces on the Project for the purpose of providing additional services related to this project for a cost not to exceed \$230,000 from Sewer Fund 41506, CIP No. 44-001.0, Annual Allocation – Sewer Main Replacement and for a cost not to exceed \$311,628 from Water Fund 41500, CIP No. 73-083.0, Annual Allocation – Water Main Replacement, for a total amount not to exceed \$541,628 is approved.

5. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized, upon advice from the administering department, to transfer excess budgeted funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves.
