

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 299627

ADOPTED ON SEP 13 2004

WHEREAS, the California Performance Review [CPR] included Recommendation RES12: Restructure Funding and Governance for Certain Land Conservancies in its final report to Governor Arnold Schwarzenegger last August; and

WHEREAS, the recommendation includes the dissolution of the San Diego River Conservancy[SDRC], as well as five other state conservancies the CPR claimed to be of "non-statewide significance;" and


WHEREAS, the CPR has failed to recognize the natural, historical, cultural and recreational value of the San Diego River [River] in concluding that it has no statewide significance, all more particularly described in a Report from the City of San Diego, Governmental Relations Department dated September 1, 2004; and

WHEREAS, because the City continues to believe the River is a resource of statewide significance which has an excellent cost-to-benefit ratio as a conservancy and that this resource can substantially benefit in the future from continued classification as a state conservancy area;

NOW, THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the City strongly opposes recommendation RES 12 from the CPR.
