
WHEREAS, the County of San Diego has been awarded \$10,383,187 under the FY04 State Homeland Security Grant Program to prevent, deter, respond to, and recover from incidents of terrorism involving the use of chemical, biological, radiological, nuclear, and explosive weapons and cyber attacks; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego has been allocated \$1,758,903 of these funds to be spent on first responder personal protective equipment, special law enforcement needs, and the City's Interoperable Communications Project; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the City Manager, Deputy City Manager, or Director of the Office of Homeland Security, is authorized, for and on behalf of the City, to accept, expend, appropriate, and administer the grant funds from the FY04 State Homeland Security Grant Program, in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the FY04 State Homeland Security Grant Program.
2. That the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby authorized to establish a special grant fund account to facilitate the grant process.
