WHEREAS, California Streets and Highways Code section 8330 et seq. provides a procedure for the summary vacation of public street easements by City Council resolution where the easements are no longer required; and

WHEREAS, the affected property owner has requested the vacation of a Portion of the alley in Block 3, Map No. 915, lying between High and Cabrillo Avenues north of Pearl Street, to unencumber this property; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that:

- (a) there is no present or prospective use for the purpose for which it was originally acquired, or for any other public use of a like nature that can be anticipated; and
 - (b) the public will benefit from the vacation through improved utilization of land; and
- (c) the vacation does not adversely affect the General Plan or an approved Community Plan; and
- (d) the public street system for which the right-of-way was originally acquired will not be detrimentally affected by this vacation, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That a Portion of the northerly terminus of the unimproved alley lying between High and Cabrillo Avenues north of Pearl Street, as more particularly described in the legal description marked as Exhibit "A," and shown on Drawing No. 19811-1-B, marked as

Exhibit "B," and on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document Nos. RR-299695, and RR-299695, which are by this reference incorporated herein and made a part hereof, is ordered vacated, reserving therefrom a general utility and access easement together with ingress and egress for that purpose.

3. That the City Clerk shall cause a certified copy of this resolution, with attached exhibits, attested by him under seal, to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder.
