WHEREAS, San Diego City College is a valued member of our community and the campus is an integral feature of the development of the park-to-bay link in East Village; and

WHEREAS, San Diego City College faces a bright future with the prospect of updating and expanding its campus to serve the students of the 21st century, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the citizens of San Diego, does hereby recognize and commend the exceptional contributions that San Diego City College has made to the San Diego region.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that September 24, 2004, be and is hereby proclaimed to be "SAN DIEGO CITY COLLEGE 90th ANNIVERSARY DAY" in the City of San Diego.
