WHEREAS, the San Diego Public Library is requesting authorization to accept and expend funding from the California State Library Services and Technology for "Cuenteme un Cuento/Tell Me a Story," part of a statewide pilot program called Cultural Crossroads; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project would allow San Diego Public Library to present a series of programs at the downtown Central Library, Linda Vista Branch Library, and City Heights Weingart Branch, and will be offered to residents citywide at no charge; and

WHEREAS, in order to facilitate and promote dialogue and collaboration among this community and the larger San Diego community, the San Diego Public Library will provide multifaceted programs with its partner: The San Diego Latino Film Festival under the Media Arts Center San Diego, and

WHEREAS, the program will be directly appealing to the growing Latino community, and will give other San Diego residents opportunities to learn about the rich heritage of the Latino culture; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to accept and expend Library Services and Technology Act grant funds from the California State Library in the amount of \$25,000 for the purpose or presenting the community program "Cuenteme un Cuento/Tell Me a Story."

- 2. That the City Manager or his designee is authorized to submit all documents, negotiate and execute all agreements necessary, including any amendments, to comply with the grant requirements, and to carry out and administer all obligations, responsibilities, and duties under the grant.
- 3. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is hereby authorized to establish a fund for the purpose of handling the accounting to facilitate the process of tracking revenue and expenditures for this project.
