A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AMENDING THE PARK AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT SWIMMING FACILITIES' ADMISSION FEE AND SWIMMING POOL RENTALS, EXCLUSIVE USE AND NON-EXCLUSIVE USE RATES.

WHEREAS, on June 28, 2004, by Resolution No. R-299382, the Council of the City of San Diego approved a new Fiscal Year 2005 Budget Fee Schedule, including increases in fees charged by the Park and Recreation Department for various programs in the City Aquatics Program, *i.e.*, the Swimming Facility Admission fee, which went into effect on July 1, 2004, and Swimming Pool Rentals fee, which went into effect on September 1, 2004; and

WHEREAS, it has become necessary to amend the Fiscal Year 2005 Budget Fee Schedule; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Swimming Facility Admission fee is amended to eliminate the requirement that "All patrons entering the facility during recreational/open swim times are required to pay the facility admission fee," which eliminates a requirement for persons who do not go into the water, but who accompany others who do (such as a parent/guardian accompanying a child) from having to pay to enter a pool facility during "open swim." All persons entering the facility to go into the water would still be required to pay the Swimming Facility Admission fee.

2. That Swimming Pool Rentals, Exclusive Use and Non-Exclusive Use rates are amended to allow all San Diego youth aquatic teams, from all public and private agencies, to pay the same Hourly Rental fees as are currently charged to Public Schools and Public Colleges. These fees, for non-City teams, other than Public Schools and Public Colleges, were approved to be raised by the Council on June 28, 2004, and the fees for Public Schools and Public Colleges were kept at their same rates as the previous year by the City Council.
