

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 299839

ADOPTED ON NOV 15 2004

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE EXTENSION OF THE NORTH PARK PROJECT AREA COMMITTEE FOR ONE YEAR AND DIRECTING THAT THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY STAFF NOTICE AND CONDUCT ELECTION FOR THE PROJECT AREA COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS, California Community Redevelopment Law allows the Project Area Committee to function for a three-year period after the adoption of the Redevelopment Plan, and for one-year extensions thereafter by approval of the Council of the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, on October 16, 1990, the City Council of the City of San Diego [Council], by Resolution No. R-276720, adopted the formation procedures for the North Park Redevelopment Project Area Committee [PAC]; and

WHEREAS, on May 20, 2003, the Council, by Resolution No. R-297999, directed that amendments to the procedures for the remaining three Community and Economic Development administered PACs, including the North Park PAC be made; and

WHEREAS, the Council by Resolution No. R-298703 adopted on December 8, 2003, the amendments to the procedures; and

WHEREAS, the amended procedures now require that the Council authorize the Agency staff to notice and conduct the PAC elections; and

WHEREAS, the Project Area Committee continues to be a valuable community advisory board to the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego as follows:

1. That the North Park PAC is extended for one year from October 16, 2004, to October 16, 2005.

2. That the staff of the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego is directed to notice and conduct the North Park PAC elections in 2005.
