WHEREAS, as proposed, this position will be responsible for the multi-media development of training videos, conference presentations material and news releases for the department, as well as developing and administering policies and procedures; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission has reviewed the justification for the position and has commented favorably thereon in its memo to the Mayor and Council dated July 7, 2005; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That pursuant to section 117(a)17 of the City Charter, after having been reviewed and commented upon favorably by the Civil Service Commission on July 7, 2005 as meeting the Charter criterion for exemption from the classified service, and after having considered and reviewed the report thereon from the Civil Service Commission to the Mayor and Council dated July 7, 2005, attached hereto as Attachment A, the position of Program Manager

be and is hereby exempted from the classified service and declared to be in the unclassified service of the City of San Diego

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its final passage, a written or printed copy having been available to the City Council and the public a day prior to its final passage.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

Charter Section 117 states that the Unclassified Service shall include "managerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating and administering department policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempt from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and approval of the City Council."

Upon review of the duties and responsibilities of this position, the Commission finds that it meets the intent of Charter Section 117. If additional information would be of assistance in your consideration of this matter, staff is available to respond with details as necessary.
