ADOPTED ON JAN 24 2005

WHEREAS, for twenty years, the Friends of San Diego Architecture has been meeting at the New School of Architecture and Design with monthly meetings featuring an architect or designer's slide show followed with a group discussion; and

WHEREAS, the success of the Friends of San Diego Architecture can be accredited to Harriet Gill's skill at moderating, her charm at enticing busy professionals to say yes when asked to speak, and her warmth in welcoming strangers at the meetings; and

WHEREAS, Harriet Gill has won awards from the American Institute for Architects and the Save Our Heritage Organization for her efforts to educate and enlighten many San Diegans with the beauty and science of architecture; and


WHEREAS, as a special project to start its twentieth year, the Friends of San Diego Architecture presented "Accessory Dwelling Units: Inspired Solutions for Our Community," an architectural design competition for professionals and architecture students; and

WHEREAS, at its January 15th meeting, the Friends of San Diego Architecture will announce and honor the winning designs at an Award Ceremony; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, does hereby recognize Harriet Gill and the Friends of San Diego Architecture for its contribution to the architectural and design community of San Diego.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that January 15, 2005, be and is hereby proclaimed to be **“HARRIET GILL AND FRIENDS OF SAN DIEGO ARCHITECTURE DAY”** in the City of San Diego.
