A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR AND ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS FROM THE CALIFORNIA INTEGRATED WASTE MANAGEMENT BOARD.

WHEREAS, funds are allocated and available from the California Integrated Waste

Management Board for grants to solid waste Local Enforcement Agencies (LEA) and cities and
counties with regulatory authority within the city and county government to perform
enforcement/compliance and surveillance activities at waste tire facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) was authorized in November 1997, by the California Integrated Waste Management Board to carry out the duties and responsibilities of solid waste inspection, permitting and enforcement within the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the LEA proposes to request grant funds to further implement an effective waste tire inspection and compliance program which will provide guidance to waste tire generators, haulers, facilities and, when necessary, take enforcement actions to remedy threats to the public health, safety and the environment; and

WHEREAS, the California Integrated Waste Management Board has been delegated the responsibility for the administration of the program within the state, setting up necessary procedures governing application by cities and counties under the program; and

WHEREAS, the applicant demonstrates it has sufficient staff resources, technical

expertise, and/or experience with similar projects to carry out the proposed program; and

WHEREAS, the applicant will enter into an agreement with the State of California for

implementation of a waste tire enforcement program; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOVLED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the City Manager is authorized to accept and expend funds from the Waste

Tire Enforcement grant program per the attached application, which has already been submitted

to the California Integrated Waste Management Board for review.

2. That the City Manager and/or his designee, is hereby authorized to conduct

negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including but not limited to applications, grant

agreements, amendments and payment requests which may be necessary to carry out and

administer the City's obligations, responsibilities and duties under the terms and conditions of

the grant.

3. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to create a separate fund for

the monies.
