

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 300086

ADOPTED ON JAN 31 2005

WHEREAS, the San Diego Police Department wishes to apply for and if selected, to accept and expend a grant from the United States Department of Justice, National Institute of Justice, for the purpose of improving efficiency of the DNA analytical process, expand storage capacity for biological evidence and improve access to information technology, as described in the grant documents, a copy of which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document RR - 300086; and

WHEREAS, grant monies will be used, in part, to fund the purchase of various types of instrumentation and equipment, and improve analysts; access to information technology; and

WHEREAS, the monies will be spent to solve crimes; thus, protecting the safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of San Diego; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Chief of Police be, and is hereby authorized and empowered, for an on behalf of the City of San Diego, to apply for, accept, manage and expend this grant, including any contracts, amendments, extensions, or renewals, for a period of up to five years, provided funding is made available by the United States Government.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council hereby authorizes the Chief of Police to execute all aspects of program operation, including any contracts, amendments, extensions, or renewals, and to certify that the City will comply with all applicable statutory or regulatory requirements related to this program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any resources received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body, and any personnel positions funded hereunder shall not be subject to hiring freezes.
