

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 300087

ADOPTED ON JAN 31 2005

WHEREAS, the San Diego Police Department wishes to apply for and, if selected, to accept and expend a grant from the United States Department of Justice, National Institute of Justice, for the purpose of identifying and testing backlogged forensic DNA casework samples, as well as a significant number of "lesser felony" cases, as described in the grant application, a copy of which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document RR - 300087 ; and

WHEREAS, grant monies will be used, in part to fund the purchase of various types of DNA kits and to fund overtime expenses; and

WHEREAS, the monies will be spent to solve crimes; thus, protecting the safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of San Diego; NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Chief of Police be and is hereby authorized and empowered, for an on behalf of the City of San Diego, to apply for, accept, manage and expend this grant including any contracts, amendments, extensions or renewals for a period of up to five years, provided funding is made available by the United States Government.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the council hereby authorizes the Chief of Police to execute all aspects of program operation, including any contracts amendments, extensions, or renewals and to certify that the City will comply with all applicable statutory or regulatory requirements related to this program.



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any resources received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body, and any personnel positions funded hereunder shall not be subject to hiring freezes.
