WHEREAS, the Department of Homeland Security [DHS] is working with the public and private sectors to ensure that protective measures are implemented to secure the United States from terrorist attacks; and


WHEREAS, as part of the national effort to protect critical infrastructures and key assets, DHS Protective Security Division is assisting state and local authorities in developing Buffer Zone Protection Plans [BZPPs]; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of a BZPP is to make it more difficult for terrorists to conduct surveillance or successfully launch an attack from the vicinity, or zone, immediately surrounding the critical infrastructure site; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the City Manager, Deputy City Manager, or his designated representative, is hereby authorized, for and on behalf of the City, to accept up to \$50,000 worth of equipment for each Buffer Zone Protection Plan completed and approved by the Department of Homeland Security.
2. That the City Manager, or his designated representative, is hereby authorized to take all necessary actions to secure the equipment from the Department of Homeland Security.
