

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 300157

ADOPTED ON FEB 28 2005

WHEREAS, on July 26, 2004, the Council of the City of San Diego adopted Resolution No. R-299482, accepting State of California Department of Education grant funds for Fiscal Year 2005, and authorizing the City Manager to enter into an agreement with the San Diego Unified School District [District] reflecting the additional grant funds ["6 to 6" Agreement]; and

WHEREAS, the "6 to 6" Agreement provides for the City to receive State and federal grant funds from the District for the operation of San Diego's "6 to 6" Extended School Day Programs; and

WHEREAS, the District was recently awarded 21st Century Community Learning Centers [21st CCLC] grant funds in the amount of \$2,719,781 for the period May 5, 2004 through June 30, 2005 to fund "6 to 6" Programs at nineteen schools and expand student participation at fourteen currently funded schools; and

WHEREAS, the additional funds will increase the total amount of grant funding to be transferred to the City from the District for the period May 5, 2004 through June 30, 2005, from \$14,036,550 to \$16,756,331; and

WHEREAS, on February 8, 2005, the Board of Education approved the increased transfer of funds to the City and the amendment to the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC grant funds are awarded for a five-year period; and

WHEREAS, to be eligible for grant funds, 40% of the overall school population must meet the "Free and Reduced Lunch" low income standard established by the California Department of Education; and

WHEREAS, the newly grant funded schools are: Alcott, Bethune, Cabrillo, Dana, Doyle, Fletcher, Foster, Fulton, Grant, Hawthorne, King/Chavez, Mason, Preuss, Promise Charter, Sequoia, Spreckels, Vista Grande, Walker, and Zamorano; and

WHEREAS, the following sites are receiving additional grant funds: Baker, Balboa, Bayview Terrace, Chollas/Mead, Darnall, Florence, Garfield, Johnson, Kennedy, King, McKinley, Roosevelt, Toler, and Washington; NOW THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego as follows:

1. That the City Manager is authorized to accept the State of California Department of Education grant funds awarded to San Diego's "6 to 6" Program.
2. That the City Manager is authorized to enter into agreements to expend these funds, beginning Fiscal Year 2005 through 2009.
3. That the City Manager is authorized to execute the First Amendment to the Agreement Between the San Diego Unified School District and the City of San Diego, on file in

the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 300157, reflecting the additional grant funds.
