DECLARING THE INTENT OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO TO USE PROCEEDS OF INDEBTEDNESS TO REIMBURSE ITSELF FOR EXPENDITURES IN CONNECTION WITH THE PURCHASE OF A BELL 212HP FIRE/RESCUE HELICOPTER.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego [City], intends to purchase one Bell 212HP fire/rescue helicopter; and

WHEREAS, the City may be in a position to finance the purchase of the helicopter with appropriate debt financing, and expects to pay certain expenditures [Reimbursement Expenditures] in connection with the purchase of the helicopter prior to issuance of such debt financing; and

WHEREAS, in the event the City exercises its discretion to issue debt financing for the purpose of the helicopter, the City reasonably expects that such debt financing will be in a total amount not expected to exceed \$5 million dollars, and that certain of the proceeds of such debt obligations will be used to reimburse the Reimbursement Expenditures; and

WHEREAS, section 1.150-2 of the United States Treasury Regulations requires the City to declare its reasonable official intent to reimburse prior expenditures for the helicopter with proceeds of a subsequent borrowing if any; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the City finds and determines that the foregoing recitals are true and correct.
- 2. That this Declaration of Intent is made solely for purposes of establishing compliance with the requirements of Section 1.150-2 of the United States Treasury Regulations. This

Declaration of Intent does not bind the City to make any expenditure, incur any indebtedness, or proceed with the purchase of the Helicopter.

- 3. That the City hereby declares its official intent that, if the city is able to finance the purchase of the helicopter with debt financing, the city will use proceeds of such debt financing to reimburse itself for Reimbursement Expenditures.
 - 4. That this Declaration of Intent shall take effect from and after its adoption.
