WHEREAS, each season, through the North American Voices Project, which became a model for opera companies throughout the United States, San Diego Opera adds contemporary American operas to complement its traditional repertoire; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Opera brings music and arts to 100,000 school children in San Diego County and Northern Mexico through Operation: Opera, an extensive and diverse opera education and outreach program; and

WHEREAS, this year San Diego Opera will celebrate its 40th anniversary; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, does hereby recognize San Diego Opera for being an invaluable cultural resource in San Diego.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that March 7, 2005, be and is hereby proclaimed to be "SAN DIEGO OPERA DAY" in the City of San Diego.
