## RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 300214 ADOPTED ON MAR 1 4 2005

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE COLLECTION OF AN APPLICATION FEE BY THE ENTERPRISE ZONE ADMINISTRATOR FOR EACH APPLICATION IT ACCEPTS FOR ISSUANCE OF A CERTIFICATE PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA REVENUE AND TAXATION CODE SECTION 17053.74(C) AND CALIFORNIA REVENUE AND TAXATION CODE SECTION 23622.7(C).

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Government Code section 7076(c), the Department of Housing and Community Development [Department] shall assess each enterprise zone a fee of not more than \$10.00 for each application it accepts for issuance of a certificate pursuant to California Revenue and Taxation Code section 17053.74(c) and California Revenue and Taxation Code section 23622.7(c) [Hiring Tax Credit Certificate]; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Government Code section 7076(c), an enterprise zone administrator is permitted to collect the \$10.00 application fee on behalf of the Department for each application it accepts for issuance of a Hiring Tax Credit Certificate; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to article XI, section 7 of the California Constitution, the City may establish a local application fee for each application an enterprise zone administrator accepts for issuance of a Hiring Tax Credit Certificate to help offset local administrative costs; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the City Council of the City of San Diego hereby establishes a total application fee of \$50.00 for each application it accepts for issuance of a Hiring Tax Credit Certificate.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that should the \$10.00 application fee collected on behalf of the Department sunset, then the total application fee would be reduced to \$40.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution shall take effect thirty days after notifications are mailed to affected or interested parties in accordance with Council Policy 100-05.
