FOURTH AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN
THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AND MOTOROLA, INC., TO
EXTEND THE EXISTING AGREEMENT, AS MODIFIED
THROUGH SEPTEMBER 23, 2010.

WHEREAS, on or about September 24, 1990, The City of San Diego and Motorola, Inc. entered into an agreement for a public safety 800 MHz radio and dispatch console system, under the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No.: RR-276605; and

WHEREAS, on or about April 6, 1992 the parties entered into a First Amendment to the Agreement under the terms and conditions set forth in the First Amendment on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-279730; and

WHEREAS, on or about April 17, 1995, the parties entered into a Second Amendment to the Agreement under the terms and conditions set forth in the Second Amendment on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-285604; and

WHEREAS, on or about October 2, 1995, the parties entered into a Third Amendment to the Agreement under the terms and conditions set forth in the Third Amendment on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. O-18221; and

WHEREAS, the Third Amendment extended the existing Agreement through September 23, 2005; and

WHEREAS, the parties now desire to extend the original Agreement together with all the rights and obligations of the Agreement, as amended for an additional five (5) years beginning on September 24, 2005 and concluding on September 23, 2010.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the City Manager be and is hereby authorized and empowered to execute, for and on behalf of said City, a Fourth Amendment to the Agreement with Motorola, Inc., to extend the existing Agreement, as modified by prior amendments, through September 23, 2010, under the terms and conditions set forth in the Fourth Amendment on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No.: RR- 300219.
