A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO TO TRANSFER THE AMOUNT OF \$556,723 FROM THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO COMMUNITY AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT TO THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO CENTRE CITY REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT'S LOW AND MODERATE-INCOME HOUSING FUND TO PROVIDE FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A KITCHEN, DINING ROOM AND CHILDREN'S PLAY AREA AT THE CORTEZ HILL FAMILY CENTER

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego [City] is engaged in activities necessary to construct and operate the Cortez Hill Family Center, a transitional housing facility for homeless families with children [Project]; and

WHEREAS, in order to construct the Project, the City has a total of \$556,723 in funds available from the Community and Economic Development Department for construction of a kitchen, dining room and children's play area; and

WHEREAS, the City has duly considered construction of the Project contained therein, it is in the best interest of the City and the health, safety, morals, and welfare of its residents, and in accord with the public purposed and provisions of applicable State and local law and requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Project is located in the Centre City Redevelopment Project Area;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City of San Diego as follows:

1. That it hereby approves the transfer of \$556,723 from the City Community and Economic Development Department to the Redevelopment Agency Centre City Redevelopment Project Low and Moderate Income Housing Fund.

2. That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized, for and on behalf of the City, to draft and execute an agreement between the Agency and the City of San Diego to facilitate the transfer of funds.

3. That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized, on behalf of the City, to sign all documents necessary and appropriate to carry out and implement the transfer and agreement between the Agency and the City of San Diego and to administer the City's obligations, responsibilities, and duties to be performed thereunder.
