A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING APPLICATIONS FOR CALIFORNIA INTEGRATED WASTE MANAGEMENT BOARD GRANTS; DESIGNATING THE DEPUTY ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES DIRECTOR TO SIGN GRANT DOCUMENTS; AND CONTINUING CITY STAFFING TO IMPLEMENT THE GRANTS, CONTINGENT ON APPROVAL OF THE FISCAL YEAR 2006-2010 BUDGETS.


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the City Manager is hereby authorized to apply for and accept one-to-three year California Integrated Waste Management Board [CIWMB] household hazardous waste/used oil recycling grants, other CIWMB oil grants, and augmented awards for Fiscal Years 2006-2008.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Environmental Services Department Deputy Director is hereby designated as the person authorized to apply for, accept, and sign all CIWMB household hazardous waste/used oil recycling grant documents and agreements on behalf of the City.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that contingent upon approval of the Fiscal Year 2006-2010 budgets and upon award of grant funding for the corresponding fiscal years, the continued staffing to implement and administer CIWMB-approved grant activities and agreements is hereby authorized.
