RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 300362

ADOPTED ON **APR 1 9 2005**

WHEREAS, severe damage to land and building property from heavy rains, mudslides, flooding and landslides occurred in the City of San Diego as well as other regions of California as the result of winter storm activity that occurred during the periods from December 27, 2004 to January 11, 2005, and February 12 to 24, 2005; and

WHEREAS, the Governor of California has declared a state of emergency as a result of both the January and February winter storms for six California counties, including San Diego County which includes the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, on February 28, 2005, the Mayor and City Council voted unanimously to proclaim a local state of emergency due to flooding from the February rains storms; and

WHEREAS, property site damage includes mudflows that encroached into City right-ofway sidewalks and streets; and

WHEREAS, displaced soil and loose debris may be transported to the storm drain systems and clog those systems when future rainstorms occur; and

WHEREAS, future rainstorms may cause further damage to unmitigated landslide or mudflow sites with the damage causing landslides or mudflows to occur on adjacent private and public properties; and

WHEREAS, authorized State and Federal assistance is being provided as a result of the rainstorm disasters making homeowners, renters, and businesses eligible for disaster aid; and

WHEREAS, granting a fee waiver to permit applicants for building permits and demolition permits will allow victims of the rainstorms to expeditiously obtain building permits and begin the rebuilding of their homes or businesses; and

WHEREAS, the expeditious rebuilding of homes and businesses in the City of San Diego will restore a sense of community and well-being within the neighborhoods destroyed by the rainstorms; and

WHEREAS, the expeditious removal of debris and other flood related waste will prevent the washing away of the waste into the City's storm drain system; and

WHEREAS, waiving waste disposal fees for properties that are designated by the City of San Diego as red tag or yellow tag damage sites signifying imminent or some risk to life or safety will facilitate and encourage the expeditious removal of debris and other flood related waste that could otherwise remain on site; and

WHEREAS, establishing October 15, 2005, as the final date for eligible property owners to apply for building permit and waste disposal fee waivers will provide adequate time to submit fee waiver applications before the start of the 2005-2006 rainy season; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the People's Ordinance, codified at San Diego Municipal Code section 66.0127(c)(4) and Government Code section 66016, this one time fee waiver will not require an increase in disposal fees for other Miramar Landfill users, if the Environmental Services Department is fully reimbursed from the General Fund or other source; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Government Code section 66005, this one time fee waiver to permit applicants and users will not require an increase of fees for other permits or

users, if the Development Services Department is fully reimbursed from the General Fund or other source; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the City Council hereby authorizes the waiver of building permit fees relating to building structures damaged by the winter 2005 rainstorms, for waiver applications filed on or before October 15, 2005.
- 2. That the City Council hereby waives the waste disposal fees at the Miramar Landfill for flood related debris generated within the City of San Diego from properties destroyed or damaged by the winter 2005 rainstorms, for waiver applications filed on before October 15, 2005.
- 3. That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Auditor and Comptroller to reimburse the Development Services and Environmental Services Enterprise Funds for fees waived in an amount not to exceed \$205,000 from the General Fund.
