A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO RESCINDING RESOLUTION R-300207, IN WHICH THE CITY COUNCIL DECLINED THE OFFER OF THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT TO ACCEPT TRANSFER OF TITLE TO THE MT. SOLEDAD MEMORIAL PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego on March 8, 2005, adopted Resolution No. R-300207 entitled, "A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DECLINING TO ACCEPT THE OFFER OF THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT TO ACCEPT TRANSFER OF TITLE TO THE MT. SOLEDAD MEMORIAL PROPERTY"; and

WHEREAS, on April 7, 2005, a referendary petition requesting the City Council to repeal Resolution No. R-300207 or submit that resolution to the registered voters of the City for their approval or rejection was filed in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-300437; and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk has found the referendary petition to contain the requisite number of valid signatures and to be in proper form and has so certified, and presented this petition, with certification attached, to the City Council on May 17, 2005; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to San Diego Municipal Code section 27.1131 and 27.1132, the City Council must reconsider Resolution No. R-300207 within ten business days of the City Clerk's presentation of the petition, and either rescind the resolution or submit the matter to the

people at an election at which all the voters of the City are entitled to vote; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that Resolution No. R-300207 is hereby rescinded.
