

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 300474

ADOPTED ON MAY 24 2005

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SAN DIEGO HOUSING COMMISSION PRESIDENT AND CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO: (1) SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR FUNDING OF A LEAD HAZARD REDUCTION DEMONSTRATION GRANT TO THE U. S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING & URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD); AND (2) IF FUNDS ARE AWARDED, AMEND THE FY06 HOUSING COMMISSION BUDGET TO REFLECT THE ADDITIONAL FUNDS; AND (3) EXECUTE CONTRACTS WITH HUD AND PARTICIPATING NON-PROFIT AGENCIES AND CITY DEPARTMENTS.

WHEREAS, the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) published a Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) for the Lead Hazard Reduction Demonstration Grant Program for Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2005; and


WHEREAS, the San Diego Housing Commission seeks to apply for approximately \$4 million in funding for a Lead Hazard Reduction Demonstration Grant Program to be implemented citywide in the City of San Diego on older residences likely to contain lead-based paint and occupied by low-income households with children; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the President and Chief Executive Officer of the San Diego Housing Commission is authorized to: (1) apply to HUD for the new grant funding; and, if awarded, (2) execute contracts with HUD to accept the funds; (3) execute contracts with

participating non-profit agencies and city departments to implement the program; and (4) amend the FY06 Housing Commission Budget to accept the funds.

This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
