A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING GRANT FUNDS FOR SAN DIEGO'S "6 TO 6" PROGRAM AT FAITH-BASED SCHOOLS.

WHEREAS, San Diego's "6 to 6" Program operates at a total of 178 schools in Fiscal Year 2005, which includes six grant funded faith based schools serving low income communities: Our Lady of the Sacred Heart (CD3); St. Rita's (CD4); Holy Family (CD6); Our Lady of Guadalupe (CD8); Our Lady of Angels (CD8); St. Jude (CD8); and

WHEREAS, primary funding for these "6 to 6" sites comes from \$660,480 in federal 21<sup>st</sup>

Century Community Learning Center [CCLC] grant funds that are administered by the State of

California Department of Education; and

WHEREAS, in December 2004, the City was notified that a one-time competitive grant opportunity was available for Fiscal 2005 and an application was submitted; and

WHEREAS, in late March 2005, staff was notified that the City had been awarded a total of \$457,596.53 for the "6 to 6" Program at the six faith based schools; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to accept the one-time State of California Department of Education 21<sup>st</sup> Century Community Learning Center [CCLC], Grant funds awarded to the City of San Diego's 6 to 6 Program, beginning July 1, 2004 through August 31, 2005.

- 2. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to establish a separate interest-bearing fund for the Grant.
- 3. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to appropriate and expend the Grant funds.
- 4. That the City Manager or his representative is authorized to negotiate and execute all agreements to expend the Grant funds.
