

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 300541

ADOPTED ON JUN 20 2005

WHEREAS, MITRE is a not-for-profit corporation chartered in 1958 to work in the public interest and is acknowledged as a national resource which applies world-class expertise in systems engineering, information technology, operational concepts, and enterprise modernization to address our nation's critical needs; and

WHEREAS, MITRE manages a Federally Funded Research and Development Center (FFRDC) for the Department of Defense known as the DOD Command, Control, Communications and Intelligence FFRDC, in addition to conducting its own independent research and development program that explores new technologies and new uses of technologies to solve our nation's problems in the near term and in the future; and

WHEREAS, MITRE employs over 5,700 scientists, engineers, and support specialists—65 percent of whom have Masters or Ph.D. degrees—at more than 60 sites around the world, working on hundreds of different projects across the company, demanding a high level of technical, operational, and domain knowledge; and

WHEREAS, for each of the past four years MITRE has been recognized by Fortune Magazine as one of the “100 Best Companies To Work For in America” in terms of overall employee satisfaction; and

WHEREAS, the MITRE FFRDC established a site in Point Loma in June 1980 to serve the Navy research and development community, principally working with Navy sponsors in


San Diego at the Space and Naval Warfare Systems Command (SPAWAR) headquarters and the SPAWAR Systems Center, that over the past 25 years has grown to now employ over 50 scientists and engineers working on numerous projects involving command, control, communications and intelligence technologies, and their application to our national defense;
