

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 300552

ADOPTED ON JUN 20 2005

WHEREAS, on June 5, 2001, the City Council adopted an ordinance, which is on file with the Office of the City Clerk as O-18945, and codified at San Diego Municipal Code sections 26.0401 to 26.0415, establishing an Ethics Commission for the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the ordinance requires the Mayor to appoint seven Ethics Commissioners from a pool of nominees submitted by the members of the City Council and City Attorney, subject to confirmation by a majority of the City Council, and

WHEREAS, the ordinance requires that the Commission reflect the diversity of the City, and requires that the Commission include at least one person who has held elective office, and at least two attorneys in good standing with the California Bar Association, and


WHEREAS, the ordinance requires that no more than three members of the Commission shall be registered with the same political party, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has appointed seven persons from the pool of City Council and City Attorney nominees who satisfy the requirements of the ordinance; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the following reappointment and appointments by the Mayor of the City of San Diego, to serve as members of the San Diego Ethics Commission, for terms ending as indicated, be and the same are hereby confirmed:
