RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO
AUTHORIZING THE CREATION OF THE OLD TOWN
COMMUNITY PARKING DISTRICT IN ACCORDANCE WITH
COUNCIL POLICY 100-18; DESIGNATING THE OLD TOWN
CHAMBER OF COMMERCE AS THE ADVISORY BOARD FOR THE
OLD TOWN COMMUNITY PARKING DISTRICT; AND
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND
EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE OLD TOWN CHAMBER OF
COMMERCE TO FULFILL ITS ANNUAL IMPLEMENTATION
PLAN.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego [Council] by Resolution No. R-288408 adopted on March 4, 1997, Council Policy 100-18 entitled the "Parking Meter Revenue Allocation and Expenditure Policy"; and

WHEREAS, the Council by Resolution No. R-299836 adopted on November 15, 2004, an amendment to Council Policy 100-18 now entitled the "Community Parking District Policy"; and

WHEREAS, the amended Council Policy 100-18 provides a mechanism for communities unable to meet existing parking demands to devise and implement parking management solutions to meet their specific needs with the formation of a Community Parking District; and

WHEREAS, the Old Town Chamber of Commerce has submitted a proposal to the City Manager, in accordance with Council Policy 100-18, requesting the formation of an Old Town Community Parking District and the designation of the Old Town Chamber of Commerce as its Advisory Board; and

WHEREAS, the Old Town Chamber of Commerce is acting on behalf of the Council to implement planning and administration of parking-related activities within the Old Town Business Improvement District; and

WHEREAS, the Advisory Board shall be designated by the Council to recommend programs and expenditures of shared parking meter and other parking related revenues;


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Old Town Community Parking District be designated with boundaries consistent with those of the Old Town Business Improvement District.
2. That the Old Town Chamber of Commerce be designated as the Advisory Board for the Old Town Community Parking District.
3. That the City Manager or designee be authorized to negotiate and execute an agreement with the Old Town Chamber of Commerce to fulfill its implementation plan.
