

RESOLUTION NUMBER R-300630

ADOPTED ON JUNE 28, 2005

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the City Manager is authorized and empowered to execute, for and on behalf of said City: (1) a Third Amendment to the Agreement with Kroll Inc., for continued provision of investigative services in their role as the City's Audit Committee, and consulting assistance in assessing internal control deficiencies affecting matters discussed in the Vinson & Elkins and City Attorney; and (2) a Second Amendment to the Agreement with Willkie, Farr & Gallagher LLP for provision of independent legal counsel to the City Audit Committee and Kroll in connection with the above matters; for a total amount not to exceed \$800,000 for both firms.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$800,000 is hereby authorized, solely, and exclusively for the purpose of providing funds for the amendments to the above agreements, contingent upon the City Auditor and Comptroller first furnishing one or more certificates demonstrating that the funds necessary for expenditures are, or will be, on deposit in the City Treasury.
