RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 300655

ADOPTED ON JUL 18 2005

WHEREAS, the San Diego Police Department has received approval for a one-time funding allotment from the State of California, Department of General Services (DGS), for Geographic Information Services (GIS) software, equipment, and services of up to \$540,000, as explained in an approval letter from DGS dated March 2, 2004, on file with the Office of the City Clerk as document RR-300655; and

WHEREAS, such fund will be used to improve the software, hardware, and services necessary for the City of San Diego's 911 system to be better able to track the location of those seeking emergency assistance; and

WHEREAS, Northrop Grumman is authorized by DGS to perform the necessary upgrade to the GIS system, and

WHEREAS, DGS will pay for all costs for the upgrades to the GIS system and no City Funds will be expended; and

WHEREAS, DGS will pay the necessary money directly to Northrop Grumman to provide the necessary upgrades but needs formal authorization from the City Council; and


WHEREAS, federal regulations require the proposed GIS upgrades to the 911 system;
NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Manager is authorized to accept these upgrades to the GIS software and equipment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is authorized to execute any documents or agreements necessary to complete the upgrade.
