A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ACCEPTING GRANT FUNDS FOR SAN DIEGO'S "6 TO 6" PROGRAM AT SIX FAITH-BASED SCHOOLS.

WHEREAS, San Diego's "6 to 6" Program operated at a total of 178 schools in Fiscal Year 2005, which included six grant funded faith-based schools serving low income communities: Our Lady of the Sacred Heart (CD3); St. Rita's (CD4); Holy Family (CD6); Our Lady of Guadalupe (CD8); Our Lady of Angels (CD8); St. Jude (CD8); and

WHEREAS, primary funding for these "6 to 6" sites came from \$660,480 in federal 21<sup>st</sup> Century Community Learning Center [21<sup>st</sup> CCLC] grant funds that are administered by the State of California Department of Education; and

WHEREAS, in June 2005, staff was notified that the City had been awarded \$8,940.82 of 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC grant funds for the "6 to 6" Program at these six faith-based schools, which will be used for Program evaluation and other grant requirement functions through August 31, 2005;

NOW, THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to accept the one-time 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC grant funds awarded to San Diego's "6 to 6" Program, beginning July 1, 2004 through August 31, 2005.

2. That the City Manager or his designee is authorized to enter into agreements to expend the grant funds.

3. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to appropriate and expend the grant funds.
