A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ACCEPTING GRANT FUNDS FOR SAN DIEGO'S "6 TO 6" PROGRAM AT SIX FAITH-BASED SCHOOLS.

WHEREAS, San Diego's "6 to 6" Program operated at a total of 178 schools in Fiscal Year 2005, which included six grant funded faith-based schools serving low income communities: Our Lady of the Sacred Heart (CD3); St. Rita's (CD4); Holy Family (CD6); Our Lady of Guadalupe (CD8); Our Lady of Angels (CD8); St. Jude (CD8); and

WHEREAS, primary funding for these "6 to 6" sites came from \$660,480 in federal 21<sup>st</sup> Century Community Learning Center [21<sup>st</sup> CCLC] grant funds that are administered by the State of California Department of Education; and

WHEREAS, in June 2005, staff was notified that the City had been awarded \$8,940.82 of 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC grant funds for the "6 to 6" Program at these six faith-based schools, which will be used for Program evaluation and other grant requirement functions through August 31, 2005; NOW, THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to accept the one-time 21<sup>st</sup>
 CCLC grant funds awarded to San Diego's "6 to 6" Program, beginning July 1, 2004 through
 August 31, 2005.

- 2. That the City Manager or his designee is authorized to enter into agreements to expend the grant funds.
- 3. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to appropriate and expend the grant funds.
