BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that it rescinds the existing Development Impact Fees [DIF] for the Mission Valley Community.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the DIF fee schedule contained in the Mission

Valley Public Facilities Financing Plan, Fiscal Year 2006, as adopted and approved on

JUL 19 2005, by Resolution No. RR-300692 [R-2005-1317], is declared to be an appropriate and applicable DIF fee schedule for all properties within the Mission Valley

Community area.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Docket Supporting Information [City Manager's Report No. <u>05-/39</u>], including all exhibits and attachments thereto, and the text contained in the Mission Valley Public Facilities Financing Plan, Fiscal Year 2006, a copy of which is on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-<u>300692</u>, are incorporated by reference into this Resolution as support and justification for satisfaction of findings required pursuant to California Government Code sections 66001(a) and 66001(b) for imposition of DIFs. Specifically, it is determined and found that this documentation:

- 1. Identifies the purpose of the DIF;
- 2. Identifies the use to which the DIF is to be put;

- 3. Demonstrates how there is a reasonable relationship between the DIF's use and the type of development project on which the DIF is imposed; and
- 4. Demonstrates how there is a reasonable relationship between the need for the public facility and the type of development project on which the DIF is imposed.
