RESOLUTION TO LEVY AND COLLECT FISCAL YEAR 2006 ANNUAL ASSESSMENTS ON VARIOUS MAINTENANCE ASSESSMENT DISTRICTS PREVIOUSLY REVIEWED AND APPROVED IN THE CITY BUDGET REVIEW PROCESS ON JUN 1, 3 2005

WHEREAS, the administration and accounting of the Bay Terraces Maintenance
Assessment District, the Mid-City Maintenance Assessment District and the Northwest Otay
Mesa Maintenance Assessment District will be better served by separate and distinct accounting
for eight areas of benefit; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that Bay Terraces Zone 5 of the Bay Terraces Maintenance Assessment District is renamed the Bay Terraces – Honey Drive Maintenance Assessment District.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Bay Terraces Zone 1 of the Bay Terraces

Maintenance Assessment District is renamed the Bay Terraces – Parkside Maintenance

Assessment District.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Sub-District #13 of the Mid-City Maintenance Assessment District is renamed the El Cajon Boulevard Maintenance Assessment District.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Sub-District #12 of the Mid-City Maintenance Assessment District is renamed the Hillcrest Maintenance Assessment District.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Sub-District #4 of the Mid-City Maintenance Assessment District is renamed the University Heights Maintenance Assessment District.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Zone 1 of the Northwest Otay Mesa Maintenance Assessment District is renamed the Ocean View Hills Maintenance Assessment District.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Zone 2 of the Northwest Otay Mesa Maintenance Assessment District is renamed the Robinhood Ridge Maintenance Assessment District.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Zone 3 of the Northwest Otay Mesa Maintenance Assessment District is renamed the Remington Hills Maintenance Assessment District.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council hereby authorizes the levy and collection of assessments in the City for the fiscal year 2006 pursuant to the provisions of the California Streets and Highways Code sections 22500 *et* seq. and San Diego Municipal Code Chapter 6, Article 5, Division 2 [Law] to pay a proscribed portion of the cost of future maintenance of improvements. These improvements are more generally described in the assessment engineers' reports, submitted in connection with the Maintenance Assessment Districts [Districts] and on file in the office of the City Clerk.



excepting therefrom all public streets, roads, alleys, avenues and highways. Reference is hereby made to the maps and the Reports for a further and more particular description of the Districts, so on file. Such maps and Reports shall govern for all details as to the extent of the Districts.

Section 3

ASSESSMENT OF COST AND EXPENSE

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the maintenance and expense of the contemplated maintenance are made chargeable upon the Districts, and the Council does declare that certain properties within the Districts receive special benefit from the maintenance of the improvements.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council shall assess those properties within the Districts which receive a special benefit from the maintenance for the total amount of the maintenance costs of the Districts, plus incidental expenses thereto, to be received by the individual parcels of real property within the Districts.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council may order a portion of the costs of maintenance to be paid by the City from appropriate funds. The proposed budget for the Districts are as follows:
