A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR A STATE GRANT TO FUND A PROPOSED MIGRANT HOUSING PROJECT.

WHEREAS, it is currently estimated that approximately 200 un-housed migrant workers reside in encampments located in the canyons, hillsides, and river beds of the coastal north city area of the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, City staff was recently informed of a state grant of up to \$3,000,000 from the California Department of Housing & Community Development, Joe Serna, Jr. Farm Worker Housing [JSJFWH] Grant Program to fund a migrant housing project in the coastal north city area of the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the JSJFWH Grant, if awarded, will be used for, among other things, each of the following: to obtain the required permits; to prepare the land; to provide water, utilities, and sewer; to place residential units on-site; and, to manage and operate the project; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the City Manager or his designee is authorized to apply for a state grant from the California Department of Housing & Community Development, Joe Serna, Jr. Farm Worker Housing Grant Program to fund a proposed migrant housing project in the coastal north city area of the City of San Diego.

- 2. That the City Manager or his designee is authorized to take the necessary actions to secure the Grant funds from the California Department of Housing & Community Development, Joe Serna, Jr. Farm worker Housing Grant Program for the proposed project.
- 3. That the City Manager or designee is authorized to accept the state Grant in an amount of up to \$3,000,000 for the proposed project.
- 4. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to accept, appropriate, and expend the Grant funds.
- 5. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to establish a separate interestbearing fund for the Grant.
