A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS THAT THE USE OF FUNDS FROM THE FISCAL YEAR 2006 CENTRE CITY REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREA'S LOW AND MODERATE INCOME HOUSING SET-ASIDE FUND WILL BE OF BENEFIT TO THE CENTRE CITY REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREA.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego [Agency] is engaged in activities necessary to carry out and implement the Redevelopment Plan for the Central Imperial Redevelopment Project Area [Project Area]; and

WHEREAS, in order to carry out and implement the Redevelopment Plan, the Agency has entered into an Exclusive Negotiation Agreement [ENA] with Barone Galasso and Associates, Inc. [Developer], which was approved by the Agency by Resolution No. 03769 and adopted on May 18, 2004, to develop the property located at Hilltop Drive and Euclid Avenue [Project Site] with 120 low-income multi-family rental units and 50 market rate single-family for-sale units; and

WHEREAS, the Agency proposes to use an amount not to exceed \$1.5 million of Centre City Redevelopment Project Area Low and Moderate Income Housing Set-Aside Funds to complete the acquisition activities, remove hazardous material, and demolish the structures on the property located at Hilltop Drive and Euclid Avenue for the purpose of developing the Project Site with the housing units described above; and

WHEREAS, the Agency has determined that the development of the Project Site is in the best interest of the City of San Diego and the health, safety, morals, and welfare of its residents, and in accord with the public purposed and provisions of applicable state and local law and requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Project Site is not within the Centre City Redevelopment Project Area, but the Agency has compiled findings of benefit to the Centre City Redevelopment Project Area that result from the development of the Project Site; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego as follows:

1. That it hereby finds and determines that, based upon the information set forth in Attachment No. 1 (attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference), the use of funds from the Centre City Redevelopment Project Area Low and Moderate Income Housing Set-Aside Fund to provide for acquisition activities, hazardous waste removal, and demolition of structures on the Project Site outside of the Centre City Redevelopment Project Area will be of benefit to the Centre City Redevelopment Project Area.

## FINDINGS OF BENEFIT TO THE CENTRE CITY REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREA

The use of funds from the Centre City Low and Moderate Income Housing Fund to assist in the financing for the acquisition of the properties located at Hilltop Drive and Euclid Avenue (Site) for the subsequent purpose of developing low and moderate income housing in southeastern San Diego. The increase in the supply of low-and moderate-income housing will be of benefit to the Centre City-Redevelopment Project Area, in that:

- Funds from the Centre City Redevelopment Project Low and Moderate Income Housing Fund will enable the Redevelopment Agency to increase and improve the supply of low- and moderate-income housing.
- The use of Agency funds for the proposed acquisition will assist in the future development of low and moderate income units on the proposed Site.
- The Centre City Redevelopment Project Area will benefit from the subsequent increase in supply of low-and moderate-income housing because of the proposed Site's proximity to downtown. People eligible to rent or purchase units on the subsequent development, that work downtown, shall be given first priority for residency.
- Readily available public transportation adjacent to the proposed site can transport residents from the proposed site and the subsequent development, to work at the Centre City Redevelopment Project Area.
