A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE SAN DIEGO UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT AND THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR FISCAL YEAR 2006

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego's "6 to 6" Extended School Day Program was initiated in 1998; and

WHEREAS, on June 3, 2003, the City Council adopted Resolution No. R-298024 to accept California Department of Education grant funds for Fiscal Years 2003 through 2007; and

WHEREAS, state and federal grant funds are passed to the City of San Diego via an Agreement with the San Diego Unified School District [District]; and

WHEREAS, the current Agreement with the District expires August 31, 2005; and

WHEREAS, the new Agreement will cover the period of September 1, 2005 - June 30, 2006, and will pass a total amount of \$13,764,663 (\$11,464,324 of After School Education and Safety Program [ASESP], and \$2,300,338 of 21st Century Community Learning Center [21st CCLC]) grant funds to the City of San Diego, based on the latest state allocations; and

WHEREAS, based on the Fiscal Year 2006 Budget, the City of San Diego will allocate \$312,800 of its general funds to San Diego's "6 to 6" Extended School Day Program for administrative costs, inclusion aides, training, and other program services; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the City Manager or his designee is authorized to enter into the Agreement between the San Diego Unified School District and the City of San Diego (also referred to as the

Memorandum of Understanding) pertaining to the operation of San Diego's "6 to 6" Extended School Day Program at District schools for the period of September 1, 2005 through June 30, 2006, which when executed, shall be placed on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. R-300761

2. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to accept the \$11,464,324 of ASESP grant funds awarded to the "6 to 6" Program.


3. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to accept the \$2,300,338 of 21st CCLC grant funds awarded to the "6 to 6" Program.

4. That the City Manager or his designee is authorized to enter into agreements with "6 to 6" providers to expend the grant funds for operation of the "6 to 6" Program at District schools for the period of September 1, 2005 through June 30, 2006, provided that the City Auditor and Comptroller first furnishes one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

5. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to appropriate and expend the grant funds.
