

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 300763

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ACCEPTING NUTRITION GRANT FUNDS FOR SAN DIEGO'S "6 TO 6" PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, there are currently 151 "6 to 6" Program sites operating in five school districts within the City limits, which include eight grant-funded schools serving low income communities: Barnard Elementary (CD2), Central Elementary (CD3), Jefferson Elementary (CD3), Our Lady of the Sacred Heart (CD3), Chollas Elementary (CD4), Mason Elementary (CD5), Emerson Elementary (CD8), and Our Lady of Angels (CD8); and

WHEREAS, primary funding for these "6 to 6" sites comes from 21st Century Community Learning Center [21st CCLC] Federal grant funds that are administered by the State of California Department of Education; and


WHEREAS, City staff was recently notified that the "6 to 6" Program was awarded a one-time Nutrition Grant of \$4,995 for these eight schools, to be used to encourage fitness and nutrition for at-risk children through various hands-on activities; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to accept the one-time 21st CCLC Nutrition Grant funds awarded to San Diego's "6 to 6" Program, beginning July 1, 2005 through September 15, 2005.
2. That the City Manager or his designee is authorized to enter into agreements to expend the grant funds.

3. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to appropriate and expend the grant funds.
