A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ACCEPTING GRANT FUNDS FOR SAN DIEGO'S "6 TO 6" PROGRAM FOR PROGRAM ENRICHMENT.

WHEREAS, there are currently 151 "6 to 6" Program sites operating in five school districts within the City limits; and

WHEREAS, City staff was recently notified that the "6 to 6" Program was awarded a one-time Program Enhancement Grant from the U.S. Department of Education Appropriations Act of 2005 in the amount of \$99,200 to be used for curriculum, training, and technology enhancements; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to accept the one-time U.S. Department of Education Appropriation Act of 2005 grant funds awarded to San Diego's "6 to 6" Program.
2. That the City Manager or his designee is authorized to enter into agreements to expend the grant funds.
3. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to appropriate and expend the grant funds.
