WHEREAS, one such vacancy was filled on July 25, 2005, when the City Council adopted Resolution No. R-300712, electing Councilmember Toni Atkins to the position of Deputy Mayor; and

WHEREAS, one vacancy currently exists on the Rules Committee; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that Councilmember

Donna Frye be and is hereby appointed to serve as a member of the Rules Committee for a term

ending December 31, 2005.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Rule 18 of the Permanent Rules of Council is hereby temporarily suspended pursuant to Rule 32 to permit the City Council to appoint a Councilmember to the Rules Committee who is other than the Mayor, Deputy Mayor, or one of the three chairpersons of the Land Use and Housing, Natural Resources and Culture, or Public Safety and Neighborhood Services standing committees.
