WHEREAS, local community groups, businesses, and schools have joined the Unified San Diego County Emergency Services Organization in advising, informing, and educating individuals about disaster preparedness; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, does hereby urge all persons to participate in the countywide Duck, Cover, and Hold Drill on Thursday, September 15, at 10:30 a.m., by taking protective actions as if an earthquake had actually occurred; and encourage all persons to

increase their knowledge and awareness of proper safety measures to follow during any emergency or disaster.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the month of September 2005 be and is hereby proclaimed to be "NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS MONTH" in the City of San Diego.
