A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR AND EXPENDITURE OF STATE GRANT FUNDS UNDER THE 2002 RESOURCES BOND ACT PER CAPITA AND ROBERTI-Z'BERG HARRIS GRANT PROGRAMS.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the City Manager or his representative is authorized to apply to the State of California for \$250,000 in Roberti-Z'berg-Harris Per Capita funds under the California Clean Water, Clean Air, Safe Neighborhood Parks, and Coastal Protection Act of 2002 for the construction of Miscellaneous Pool Improvements.
- 2. That the City Manager is authorized to take all necessary actions to secure funding from the State of California for Miscellaneous Pool Improvements.
- 3. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to accept, appropriate and expend funds, if grant funding is secured.
- 4. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to establish a special interestbearing fund for the grant.
- 5. That the Fiscal Year 2006 Capital Improvements Program is amended by adding CIP No. 29-893.0, Miscellaneous Pool Improvements.
- 6. That the Fiscal Year 2006 Capital Improvements Program Budget is amended by increasing the budget amount by \$250,000 in CIP No. 29-893.0, Miscellaneous Pool Improvements, 2002 Resources Bond per Capita funding.

7. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to appropriate and expend an amount not to exceed \$250,000 from CIP No. 29-893.0, Miscellaneous Pool Improvements, 2002 Resources Bond per Capita funding for construction of the Miscellaneous Pool Improvements, contingent upon receipt of a fully executed grant agreement.
