

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 300833

ADOPTED ON SEP 19 2005

WHEREAS, the San Diego Public Library is requesting authorization to accept and expend funding from the California State Library Services and Technology Act for “Youth Voices: Barrio Logan;” and

WHEREAS, the proposed digital storytelling project would allow the San Diego Public Library, in partnership with Media Arts Center San Diego, High Tech High, High Tech Middle School, National Latino Research Center, Barrio College Institute, Memorial Academy, and MAACSD, to present a series of educational workshops which would directly benefit teenagers and adults in the Barrio Logan area of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, in addition to learning technical skills, the young people involved with the project will connect with their history through the documentation and preservation of local stories; and

WHEREAS, community screenings will be offered to the community at large and the digital videos will be made available on DVD and will become part of the Central Library’s media collection; and

WHEREAS, the materials for the project will be paid for with \$136,367 in grant funding from the California State Library; NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego as follows:

1. That the City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to accept and expend Library Services and Technology Act grant funds from the California State Library in the amount of \$136,367 for the purpose of producing the community program "Youth Voices: Barrio Logan."

2. That the City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to submit all documents; negotiate and execute all agreements necessary, including any amendments, to comply with the grant requirements; and to carry out and administer all obligations, responsibilities, and duties under the grant.

3. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is hereby authorized to establish a fund for the purpose of handling the accounting to facilitate the process of tracking revenue and expenditures for this project.
