WHEREAS, Nora Jaeschke served as a member of the Board of Directors of the San Diego County Water Authority (CWA), representing the City of San Diego, beginning July 10, 1997; and

WHEREAS, she retired from the Board of Directors on June 6, 2005; and

WHEREAS, during her tenure, Nora served as Chair of the CWA's Planning and Environmental Committee and Audit Subcommittee; and

WHEREAS, she served as Vice Chair of the CWA's Administrative and Legal, Fiscal Policy, and Public Affairs Committees, and both the Ad Hoc Committee on Board Administration and Nominating Committee Process Subcommittee; and

WHEREAS, she served as a member of the CWA's Executive, Imported Water, and Legislation, Conservation and Outreach Committees, the Master Plan Ad Hoc Committee, and as the Water Conservation Garden JPA alternate; and

WHEREAS, she championed the cause of water conservation in the City and County of San Diego, serving as a member of the City Manager's Water Conservation Advisory Committee from 1991 to 1998, and as Co-Chair of the City's Water Conservation Action Committee from 2003 to 2005, which she formed to provide water agencies and stakeholders a forum in which to enact sound water conservation practices and policies; and

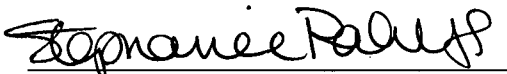
WHEREAS, her contributions to the community extend beyond the activities with the San Diego County Water Authority; and
