WHEREAS, the City of San Diego Police Department wishes to submit a grant application to the State of California Department of Boating and Waterways; and

WHEREAS, there is funding available to replace existing obsolete water patrol equipment and;

WHEREAS, if selected for funding, the funds will be used to purchase Harbor Unit equipment to replace obsolete equipment, which in turn will further community education, crime prevention, law enforcement and public safety;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any grant funds and/or resources received hereunder shall be used to supplement, and not to supplant expenditures controlled by this body; and shall not be subject to local expenditure freezes.
