WHEREAS, the Police Department of the City of San Diego wishes to participate in an application to the State of California's Office of Emergency Services for a Gang Violence Suppression grant (hereafter referred to as the Grant); and

WHEREAS, the Grant involves collaboration with other law enforcement agencies, the District Attorney, the Probation Department, San Diego Youth & Community Services, and local schools to improve public safety in the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, if the Grant is awarded to the City of San Diego, the Grant would fund a Police Officer II detective position, overtime pay for police officers addressing gang problems, a Deputy District Attorney position, a project administrator and a mentoring program, gang violence prevention training for youth and adults, and other gang violence prevention, investigation, and prosecution purposes; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego will not be required by the Grant to perform any further functions or incur further expenses after the grant's termination;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Manager is authorized to apply for, accept, and expend money from the Grant; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager shall be authorized to execute any document or other instruments necessary or proper to apply for, accept, administer, audit, or otherwise further the goals of the Grant, including but not limited to amendments, extensions, and renewals, for a period of up to five years.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is authorized to certify that the City of San Diego will comply with all statutory and regulatory obligations required to obtain, maintain, extend, or renew the Grant.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, as mandated by the terms of the Grant, funding awarded by the Grant may be used to supplement, and not to supplant, expenditures currently authorized by the City Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, as required by the Grant, any positions funded by the Grant may not be subject to any hiring freeze imposed by the City of San Diego.
