

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 300912

ADOPTED ON OCT 10 2005

WHEREAS, the Human Relations Commission is established in San Diego Municipal Code section 26.0905 to advise the Mayor, City Council, and City Manager on the rights of every inhabitant of the City of San Diego to equal economic, political and educational opportunity; to equal accommodations in all business establishments in the City; and to equal service and protection by public agencies; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Code provides that the Commission shall consist of fifteen members appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council, all of whom shall be residents of the City of San Diego unless otherwise waived by the Council pursuant to Council Policy 000-13; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Code also provides that the membership of the Commission shall consist of seven members appointed by the Mayor and eight additional members, one each from a list of up to three nominations submitted by each Councilmember; and

WHEREAS, there will be four vacancies on the Human Relations Commission due to the expired terms of Joyce Singer Abrams, Michael J. Pérez, Robert L. Blumberg, and Grover Diemert, each of which expired on July 22, 2005; and

WHEREAS, the office of Mayor is currently vacant; and

WHEREAS, San Diego City Charter section 25 requires that the Deputy Mayor perform all the duties of the Mayor as prescribed by the Charter or by ordinance in the absence of the Mayor; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the following appointments and reappointments by the Deputy Mayor of the City of San Diego to serve as

members of the Human Relations Commission, for terms ending as indicated, be and the same are hereby confirmed:

Pérez is a resident of San Diego County, but not the City of San Diego, and has unique qualifications to serve as a member of the Commission, therefore, a conscious exception to Council Policy 000-13 is hereby declared.
