A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN
DIEGO ADOPTING THE STATE ROUTE 75 (PALM AVENUE)
DEFICIENCY PLAN.

WHEREAS, a local jurisdiction is required by state law to prepare and adopt a deficiency plan [Plan] when a state route segment on the regional Congested Management Program [CMP] network fails to meet the applicable level of service standard; and


WHEREAS, Government Code Section 65089.4(c) requires a Plan to include identification of the cause of the deficiency, a list of improvements necessary to correct the deficiency and relieve congestion, and an action plan for implementing the improvements in the Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City, Caltrans, the Metropolitan Transit System, the City of Imperial Beach, the San Diego Air Pollution Control District, and the Congestion Management Agency [SANDAG] have cooperatively prepared a Plan to identify direct fix improvements on the State Route 75 (Palm Avenue, in the community of Otay Mesa-Nestor); NOW
THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by Council of the City of San Diego, that it adopts the State Route
75 Deficiency Plan, a copy of which is on file in the City Clerk as Document RR- 300963.
