WHEREAS, the 7th Annual Women's World Longboard Championships will be held at San Diego's Ocean Beach Pier on October 21-23, 2005; and

WHEREAS, this event, traditionally run by Hank Raymond and Richard Allred of Toes on The Nose, will be organized and run this year by Linda; and

WHEREAS, Linda has the assistance and support of women longboarders around the globe and this year's Championships will be the first world longboard surfing championship run by women, for women; NOW, THEREFORE,
