

## RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 300995 ADOPTED ON OCT 3 1 2005

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR AND EXPENDITURE OF FEDERAL GRANT FUNDS FOR THE OPEN SPACE BRUSH MANAGEMENT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the California Office of Emergency Services (OES), under the Robert T.

Stafford Emergency Assistance and Disaster Relief Act, PL 93-288, as amended by PL 106-390

"Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000," awards grants to local public agencies for an Open Space

Brush Management Program [Grant Program]; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to apply for a grant pursuant to the Grant Program [Grant] to implement a proposed 100-foot brush management area in the City's open space for defense against impending fire [Project]; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the City Manager or his representative is authorized to apply to the OES for the Grant for the:
  - (a) Scripps Ranch Group consisting of 280.7 acres for \$1,309,260;
  - (b) Carmel Valley Group consisting of 271.1 acres for \$1,309,260; and
  - (c) Del Cerro Group consisting of 127.6 acres for \$621,328.
- 2. That the City Manager or his representative is authorized to take all necessary actions to secure the Grant and to negotiate and execute all agreements necessary to comply with the OES's grant requirements.

- 3. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to appropriate and expend an amount not to exceed \$911,955 from AC 2400926 approved by Council Resolution R-299064, to whichever of the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program DR-1498, FY 2005 Pre-Disaster Mitigation Grant Program, or Hazard Mitigation Grant Program DR-1577/DR-1585 open space brush management grants is received first, contingent upon receipt of a fully executed grant agreement.
- 4. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to accept, appropriate and expend funds if the Grant is secured.
- 5. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to establish interest-bearing funds for the Grant.
